Structural Definition Contextual Interpretation

- New pedestrian experience via a covered colonnade from the rear car parking area to Toorak road.
- Simple box like form to Toorak road to minimise detracting from the existing building.
- Important link in the proposed future of the Toorak village Activity Centre.
